At any facility, Total above-ground fuel storage capacity of at least 1,320 gallons automatically triggers a SPCC requirement by law. This is regardless of actual fuel quantity stored onsite.

Fuel storage can add up quickly at any size facility.

It is 25 fifty-five gallon drums.



It is two IBC tanks and 15 fifty-five gallon drums.



It is a large fuel convault.
